☼ Taekwondo

In our school, ballet helps pupils develop posture, grace, and self-discipline. Through movement and performance, children gain confidence, creativity, and an appreciation for the arts.





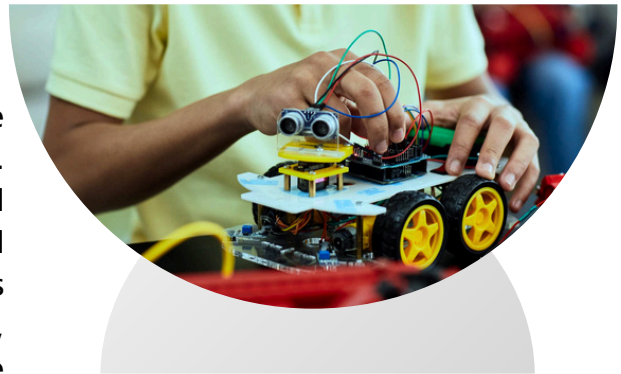
☼ STEAM

(Science Technology Engineering Art Mathematics)

In our school, STEM club inspires pupils to think like young scientists and engineers. Children engage in practical experiments, problem-solving tasks, and design challenges that encourage creativity and innovation. This club builds critical thinking skills and prepares learners for future careers in technology and science.

☼ Robotics

The Robotics club introduces pupils to the world of coding, machines, and automation. Using child-friendly kits, learners build and programme robots, helping them understand how technology works in real life. This activity strengthens logical reasoning, teamwork, and problem-solving, while making learning exciting and hands-on.



☼ Speed Maths

Speed Maths sharpens pupils' mental arithmetic and calculation accuracy. Through fun drills, number games, and timed challenges, children develop faster recall of basic operations. This helps boost confidence in mathematics and improves exam performance, while making maths enjoyable.

☼ Abacus Maths

Abacus Maths is a traditional yet highly effective method of building strong number sense and concentration. Using the abacus tool, pupils learn to visualise numbers and perform complex calculations with ease. This activity enhances memory, focus, and mathematical agility.





☘ Little Tots

Little Tots is designed especially for our youngest learners in Early Years. It provides a safe and stimulating environment where children learn through play, music, art, and movement. The focus is on building early literacy, numeracy, social skills, and creativity, laying a strong foundation for future learning.

☘ Logical Thinking

Our Logical Thinking club develops pupils' ability to reason, analyse, and solve problems systematically. Through puzzles, strategy games, riddles, and critical thinking exercises, learners strengthen their decision-making and creative problem-solving skills – abilities essential for success in academics and life.
